- 3. Trophies will be awarded for 1st place in each category. Multiple trophies will be awarded in desserts category.
- 4. Judging will follow the Coles Crossing rules below. One container of each category will be judged. All entries must be delivered for judging in containers supplied by officials during MANDATORY Event Check-In.

Check-In

- 1. A MANDATORY Event Check-In will be held on Saturday morning from 9 to 10 am. You are not required to be there the full hour just to check in.
- 2. Participants will receive containers at check-in that will be used to submit entry in each category participant has entered.
- 3. Participants will receive any necessary updates to schedule of events at this check-in should weather etc. necessitate.

Meats

- 1. Cooking Entries should be prepared at home and brought to event during turn-in times. LIMITED availability of on-site cooking may be available. Details to follow.
- 2. Entry Container Nothing but the entry should be included in the container. No garnish should be included. No dipping sauce should be included and no sauces should be applied to the meat that would leave meat during removal from the box. Entries with garnish or sauces will be disqualified.
- 3. Chicken Each participant should provide one half of a chicken with breast leg thigh and wing attached. Chicken will be inspected prior to judging and unsafe entries will be disqualified. The chicken should be presented in containers supplied by officials during MANDATORY Event Check-In.
- 4. Pork Ribs Spare or baby back ribs are both acceptable entries. Each participant should provide a minimum of 6 rib bones. Pork ribs will be inspected prior to judging and unsafe entries will be disqualified. The pork ribs should be presented in containers supplied by officials during MANDATORY Event Check-In.
- 5. Brisket Each participant should provide a minimum of 6 slices of brisket approximately ¹/₄" to 3/8" in thickness. Brisket will be inspected prior to judging and unsafe entries will be disqualified. Brisket should be presented in containers supplied by officials during MANDATORY Event Check-In.
- Judging Judges will be provided scorecards for each participant entry identified by team number not name with sample from participant entry. Each entry will be judged on a scale of 1 (inedible) to 9 (truly exceptional) on three characteristics: (a) Flavor (b) Appearance and (c) Taste.

Sides/Dessert

- 1. Sides Each participant should provide sufficient amount of your side for 5 judges to sample.
- 2. Dessert Each participant should provide sufficient amount of your dessert for 12 judges to sample.
